WHERE WAS DAVID ROWELL LAST SEEN ALIVE?

According to the prosecution David was last seen alive when Joey Shipman saw him go to Keith's trailer. We already know, from Joey Shipman's statement that this is false.

There were three pieces of evidence that were available back then but they were never brought up at trial. I believe if these pieces of evidence had been shown to the jury it would have destroyed the prosecution's theory and Keith would never have been convicted.

- 1). Jack Joyce was the first Coroner's investigator on the scene. He was never called to testify and his report was never produced. (I believe this is because his report contradicts many things the prosecution presented). Keith didn't even know Jack Joyce existed until Mr. Barnhart uncovered his report. In that report Mr. Joyce says that David was last seen by his parents at approximately 5:30pm Feb. 5th., 1982. (See Coroner's Investigator's report).
- 2). A police report, that was never produced at trial, said David Rowell was seen walking down Krietzer Rd. sometime after 7:00pm. (See police report)
- 3). In another hidden police report, Brian "Cappy" Canterbury (A friend of David's) says he believe he saw him outside of the Civic Center at approx. 9:15pm Feb. 5th. 1982. During that interview he described a coat that matches the coat found with David's body. (In an interview with Mr. Barnhart, Canterbury has no doubts that it was David he saw that night. (See police report and Canterbury interview).
